Property

Kirsty accepts instructions across a wide range of property matters including both residential and business possession claims. She is regularly instructed to draft pleadings in a property law context, and to provide formal advice in respect of the same.

Recent property work Kirsty has undertaken includes:

- Drafting a defence on behalf of a landlord to a tenant's claim for a new lease, relying on section 30(1)(f) Landlord and Tenant Act 1954, that on the termination of the current tenancy the landlord intends to demolish or reconstruct the premises.
- Successfully making an application to suspend a warrant of possession.
- Advising a landlord in relation to available options in circumstances where the tenant was subject to a breathing space moratorium.
- Advising investors in respect of their ability to argue that they have an equitable lien over a property in a development that was never completed.
