Inquests

Inquests Cases

Roger has acted for:

- The Probation Service on the death of a young offender in an accident while carrying out a supervised mountain climbing activity.
- An NHS Hospital trust on the death of a patient shortly after admission to A&E at the request of police officers due to disturbed behaviour and who was subject to restraint by hospital security officers shortly before he died.
- The family of the deceased who died in a multiple vehicle road traffic accident.
