### Cases

#### R v Brown & R v Butterworth [2007]

1 Cr App R 77; [2006] Crim L.R.1082 – guideline case concerning extended sentences of imprisonment under the CJA 2003 – Alaric was commended by the Court of Appeal for the quality of his submissions.

#### R v Edwards & others [2006]

1 Cr App R 3 – one of the first guideline cases concerning the operation of the bad character provisions of the CJA 2003.
